

Dear Members,

On behalf of the Board of Directors I present the Finley Returned Soldiers Club Annual Report for the 2020 Financial Year. This year after depreciation the club has made profit of \$249,342.00. Government assistance of Job Keeper and the Cash Flow boost were significant in the Club's survival through what was a year like no other.

The Covid 19 outbreak has presented licensed venues and businesses across the country with challenges like never before. Unfortunately, many have not survived. Our Club was closed for 10 weeks and contributed to the need of some very tough decisions. The Board and Management needed to focus on planning for and creating a financially sustainable Club for the future.

After 24 years of outstanding maintenance of the Club's bowling greens our greenkeeper Warren Blanch retired from Full Time work. He is now assisting with the maintaining club surrounds and club maintenance. Warren's advice and guidance has been sought and appreciated by bowling clubs throughout the area.

During the year we have continued to upgrade our facilities. The Sports Room toilets were completely refurbished, with the new facility providing modern male, female and disabled amenities.

Our foyer saw a much needed make over, a new ceiling and painting, enhanced by Office Manger Lita Gray's outstanding artwork attracting much interest from our members and visitors.

The RSL Sub Branch was successful in obtaining a grant through the DVA, enabling the building of new memorabilia display adding to the features on entry to the Club.

The successful application for a Building Better Regions infrastructure grant has enabled the Club to go ahead with extensive renovations to the existing kitchen and building of new toilets. The work is planned to be completed by mid year. We are all very excited to see this project start and to also give you our members a more modern facility.

The Club's catering team led by Kate Murray and our talented chefs Santosh and Sanju with new and exciting menus, resulting in a number of new faces at the Club and the offsite catering of a number of functions. The team looks forward to Debutant Balls, weddings and sporting club events in the first half of the year.

Your Club continues to contribute to our local community, with \$ 31,623 being donated to various sporting, community and welfare groups through donations, sponsorship of local sporting clubs and Club Grants funding throughout 2020.



On behalf of my Board of directors, management and staff I would like to offer my condolences to all members whose families have suffered bereavement throughout the year and for those that are ill we wish them a speedy road to recovery.

I would especially like to thank all members for their continued support and loyalty throughout the year. It is most important that we all do our best to attract new Members to the Club so they too can enjoy the benefits of being a member of the Finley RSC.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank our General Manager Sharen Parmley and to all the staff throughout the Club for their dedication, ensuring the smooth and successful operation of the Club in what has been difficult times, especially maintaining a Covid Safe facility.

Finally, a huge thank you to my fellow Directors for without their continuing support we would not have the effective and efficient Board that we do. I am fortunate to be part of a Board who are dedicated to ensuring the Club continues to grow and meet community needs.

1 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The directors have determined that the company is not a reporting entity and accordingly, this financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared for the sole purpose of distributing the financial report to the members and must not be used for any other purpose. The directors have determined that the accounting policies adopted are appropriate to meet the needs of the members.

Finley Returned Soldiers Club Limited is a company limited by guarantee, incorporated and domiciled in Australia.

Basis of Preparation

The report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Corporations Act 2001, and in accordance with Accounting Standards which include Australian equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards ('AIFRS') and other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board. Compliance with AIFRS ensures that the financial report, comprising the financial statements and notes thereto, complies with International Financial Reporting Standards ('IFRS').

AASB 101: Presentation of Financial Statements;

AASB 107: Cash Flow Statements:

AASB 108 Accounting policies, changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors;

AASB 110: Events after the Balance Sheet Date:

AASB 1004: Contributions;

AASB 1048: Interpretation and Application of Standards.

No other Accounting Standards, Accounting interpretations or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

Reporting Basis and Conversions

The financial report has been prepared on an accrual basis and is based on historical cost. It does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuation of non current assets. Cost is based on the fair values of consideration given in exchange for the asset.

The following is a summary of the material accounting polices adopted by the entity in the preparation of the financial report. The accounting polices have been consistently applied unless otherwise stated.

NOTE:

1 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (cont'd)

(a) Revenue

Revenue from the sale of goods is recognised upon delivery of the goods to the customers

Grant revenue is recognised in the income statement when it is controlled. When there are conditions attached to the grant revenue relating to the use of those grants for specific purposes it is recognised in the balance sheet as a liability until such conditions are met of services provided.

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received unless they are designated for a specific purpose, where they are carried forward as prepaid income on the balance sheet.

Interest Revenue is recognised using the effective rate method, which, for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument.

Revenue from the rendering of services is recognised upon the delivery of the services to the customers.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

(b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at cost, adjusted where applicable to for any loss of service potential.

Inventories acquired at no cost, or for nominal consideration are valued at the current replacement cost as at the date of acquisition.

(c) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, accumulated depreciation.

Property

Freehold land and buildings are measured on the fair value basis, being the amount for which an asset could be exchanged between knowledgeable willing parties in an arm's length transaction.

Plant and Equipment

Plant and equipment are measured on the cost basis less depreciation.

Depreciation

All assets, excluding freehold land, are depreciated on a diminishing basis over their useful lives to the company.

NOTE:

1 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (cont'd)

(d) Employee Benefits

Provision is made for the company's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to Balance Sheet date. Employee benefits expected to be settled within one year together with entitlements arising from wages and salaries, and annual leave which will be settled after one year, have been measured at the amount expected to be paid when the liability is settled plus related on costs. Other employee entitlements payable later than one year have been measured at the net present value.

Contributions are made by the Company to employee superannuation funds and are charged as expenses when incurred.

(e) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST is not recoverable for the Australian Taxation Office. In this circumstance the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of expense. Receivables and payables in the balance sheet are also shown exclusive of GST.

Cash flows are presented in the cash flow statement on a gross basis, except for the GST component of investing and financing activities, which are disclosed as operating cashflows.

(f) Contributions

Finley Returned Soldiers Club Limited receives non-reciprocal contributions from the government and other parties for no value or a nominal value. These contributions are recognised at fair value on the date of acquisition upon which time an asset is taken up in the balance sheet and revenue in the income statement.

(g) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the entity has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable than an outflow of economic benefit will result and that outflow can be reliably measured.

NOTE: 2 REMUNERATION OF DIRECTORS

No remuneration is paid to the Directors of the Company as the Company is limited by guarantee and cannot pay remuneration by virtue of the provisions of its Memorandum of Association.

NOTE: 3 INCOME TAX

Taxation is calculated on a formula applicable to visitors only. From 1994 onwards, the formula changed to allow for the Australian Taxation Office views on the tax treatment of commission type income. As a result, the following taxation payments and provisions were made during the financial year.
